

# International Brigade Commemorative Tour

## Remember the Ebro



The **North West Trade Union International Committee (NWTUIC)** is organising a trip to commemorate the 80<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Battle of the Ebro, the last great offensive launched by the troops of the Spanish Republic and the International Brigade Volunteers to stem the advance of Franco and his fascist hordes in the Spanish Civil war of 1936 to 1939.

Our aim is to educate today's trade union activists in the living history of our movement and in particular in the spirit of solidarity that was exemplified by the heroic struggle and sacrifice of the volunteers of the International Brigade. The Brigade was made up of working class people from around the world made a dangerous journey to Spain to try and stem the rise of fascism there and throughout Europe.

Their legacy is priceless and our tour will commemorate that legacy in order to inspire today's working class fighters in the values our trade union movement holds dear – solidarity, justice, anti-fascism and internationalism.

**The Ebro Solidarity Commemoration Tour takes place from Thursday 19 April 2018 to Monday 23 April 2018, inclusive.**

**Cost** – The cost of this trip (excluding transport to and from Calafell) is **£250**. This includes coach hire, hotel accommodation (based on two people sharing rooms), breakfast and several hotel meals. To secure a place you must pay a **£50** non-refundable deposit by 30 October 2017. The £200 balance must be paid by 15 December 2017.

**Transport** – Please arrange and pay for your own flights to Barcelona and your own train journey to Calafell. All journeys on the tour are covered.
